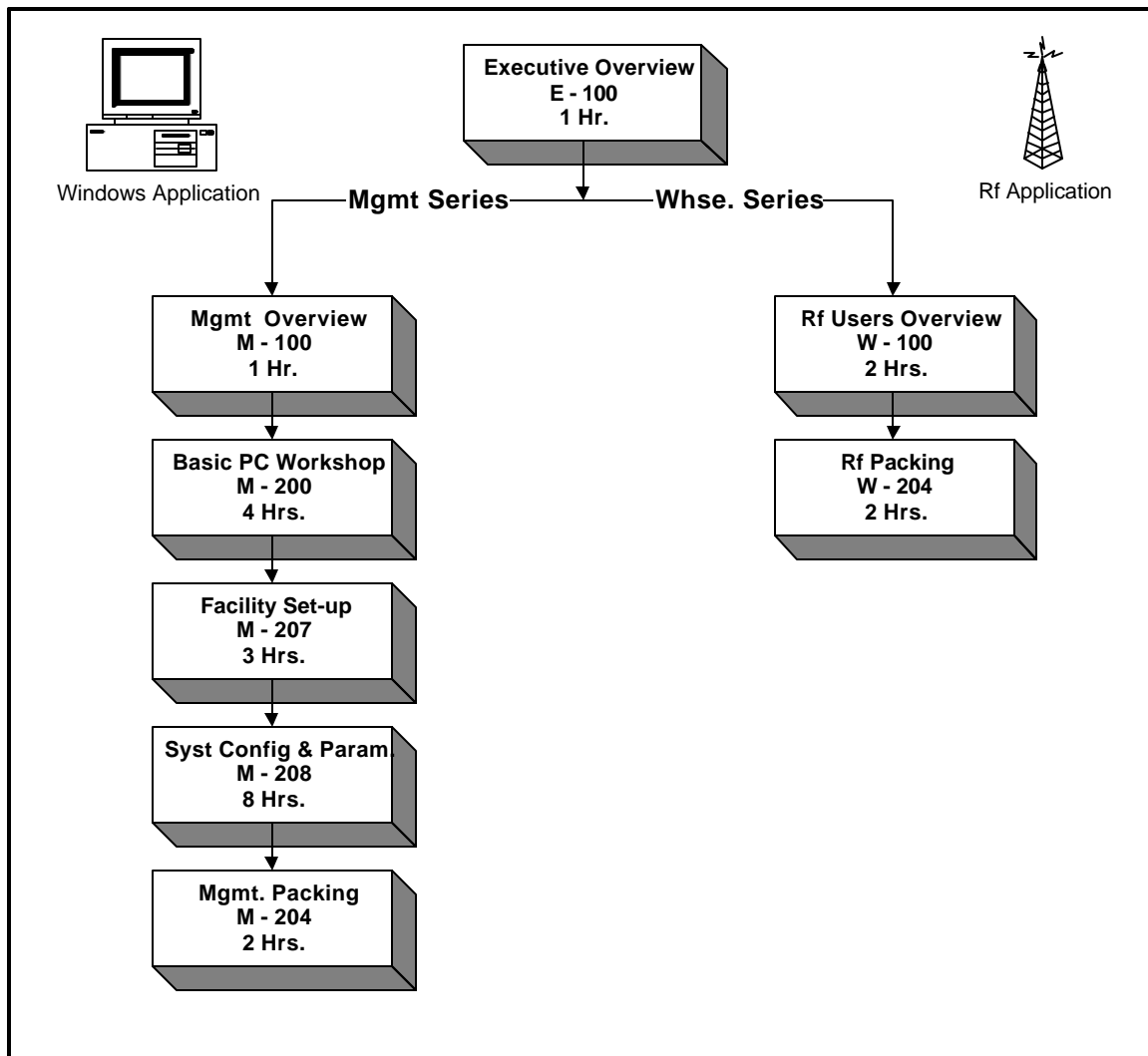
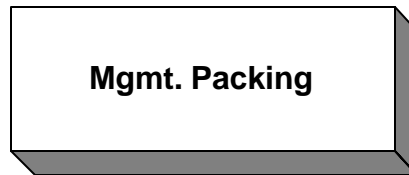


Recommended Training Path
