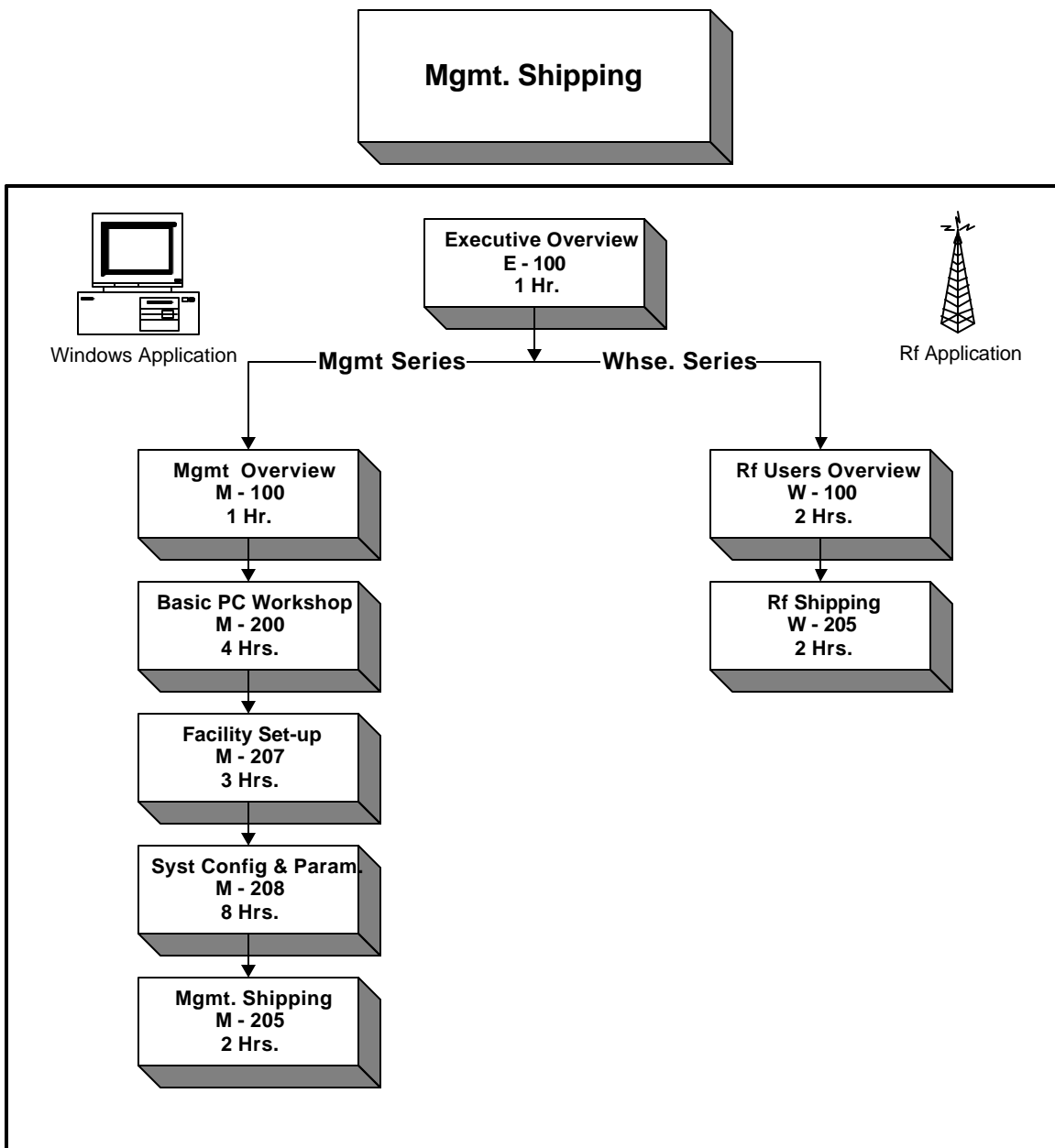


Recommended Training Path
